POWER OF ATTORNEY

AMERICAN SURETY COMPANY TO CHARLES STONE
LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the American Surety Company of New York, a corporation of the State of New York, of No. 100 Broadway, in the City of New York, in said State, has constituted and appointed, and by these presents does hereby make, constitute and appoint Chas. Stone, of Evanston, Uinta County, Wyoming, its true sufficient and lawful attorney, with full power and authority to make, execute and deliver, for it, in its name and in its behalf, as surety, at Evanston, aforesaid, bonds, undertakings or obligations as follows:

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties by Executors, administrators and Receivers and Trustees in Bankruptcy.

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000) on attachment on Garnishment, on Injunction and Security for Costs Non-Resident Plaintiff,--required to be filed in the County of Uinta, State of Wyoming, provided, however, that every such bond executed hereunder be countersigned by P. W. Spaulding, hereby giving its said attorney full power and authority to do everything whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done for the purpose of making, executing and delivering such obligations as fully as the officers of said American Surety Company of New York could do if personally present, and hereby ratifying and confirming all that its said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof, but reserving to
