VI.

Lyman Fargo of Evanston, Wyoming, William Crawford of Evanston, Wyoming, Isaac C. Winslow of Evanston, Wyoming and Charles Stone of Evanston, Wyoming.

VII.

The names of the Towns and Counties wherein the business of the said Company is to be carried on are as follows: The Town of Evanston in the County of Uinta and the State of Wyoming, and the town of Almy in said County and State, and it shall also have power to carry on any part of its business in any place or places within any State or Territory of the United States of America.

The principal part of the business of said Company within the State of Wyoming is to be transacted in the Town of Evanston in said Uinta County and said Town and County last named shall be deemed the Town, place and County in which the operations and business of said Company are to be carried on and its principal place of business.

VIII.

The Trustees of said Company shall have power to make by-laws as they shall deem proper for the management and disposition of the stock and business affairs of such Company, not inconsistent with the laws of Wyoming and prescribing the duties of officers, artificers and servants that may be employed for the appointment of all officers and for carrying on all kinds of business within the objects and purposes of said Company.
