Now know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order duly made Nov. 28-1902 and entered on the 17th day of April A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, Page 87 determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:
