Whereas, W. G. Warren has presented to the Board of Control proof of the appropriation of water from North Piney Trib to Green River through the Gilbert ditch under permit No. for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County, Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order made Nov, 28 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 92, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

Name of Appropriator W. G. Wanen: Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming; General Priority Number on main stream; 45; Priority Number on North Piney 2; Amount of Appropriation, 3.42 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation 1886; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined and established. Two hundred and Forty acres (240) acres. Being Eighty (80) acres in S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Eighty (80) acres in S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Twenty four (24) T. 31 N. R. 114 W.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
