Whereas, Ray, S. Glover has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from South Piney Trib to Green River through the Glover No. 1 Ditch under Permit No. 3222 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order duly made Nov. 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 91, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of Appropriator Ray S.
