Whereas, Jas. Michaelson has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from South Piney trib to Green River through the South Piney Ditch under permit no. 763 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County, Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1. Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has by an order duly made Nov 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903 in Order Record No. 3. page 91 determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of appropriator Jas. Michaelson; Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming/ General Priority Number on main stream; 91½ Priority Number on South Piney 12; Amount of Appropriation, 4. 56 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation July 18, 1894; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined and established.

Three hundred and twenty (320) acres---Being Forty (40) acres in Lot Four (4) Eighty (80) acres in S½ NW¼ Sec. Three (3) Forty (40) acres in Lot one (1) Forty (40) acres in SE¼ NE¼ Sec. four (4) T. 29 N. R. 112 W. Eighty (80) acres in W½ SW¼ Forty (40) acres in NE¼ SW¼ Sec. Thirty four (34) T 30 N. R. 112 W;

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Fred Bond, President of the State Board of Control, have hereunto set my hand this 28 day of May, A. D. 1903 and caused the seal of said Board to be hereunto affixed.
