Whereas, Mercia Griggs has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from South Piney Trib to Green River through the Merril Ditch under permit No. 1896 for irrigation of the lands herein described lying and being in Uinta County Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has by an order duly made Nov. 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 91, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of Appropriator Mercia Griggs; Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming; General Priority Number on main stream; 141; Priority Number on South Piney 18; Amount of Appropriation 2.29 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation June 28, 1898; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined and established. Two hundred & Thirty(230) acres. Being Twenty five (25) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Twenty five (25) acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Twenty (20) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. five (5) T 29 N. R. 111 W. Eighty (80) acres in W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Eight (8) T 29 N. R. 111 W.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Fred Bond, President of the State Board of Control, have hereunto set my hand this 28 day of May, A. D. 1903, and caused the seal of said Board to be hereunto affixed.
