Whereas, Thomas Smith, has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from North Piney Trib to Green River through the Vermillion Ditch under Permit No. 2007 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County, Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has by an order duly made Nov. 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 90, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

General Priority Number on main stream; 157; Priority Number on North Piney 21; Amount of Appropriation 3.93 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation Nov. 10-1898; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined and established. Two hundred & Seventy five (275) acres. Being Twenty five (25) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Thirty five (35) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Forty (40) acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Twenty two (22) Forty (40) acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Twenty seven (27) Thirty four (34) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Twenty five (25) acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Thirty six (36) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Twenty eight (28) T 31 N. R. 114 W.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
