Whereas, Nellie Ball has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from Cottonwood Creek Trib to Green River through the Valley Ditch under permit No. 548 for irrigation of the lands herein described and lying and being in Uinta County, Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order duly made Nov 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 100 determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of appropriator Nellie Ball; Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming; General Priority Number on main stream; 204; Priority Number on Cotton wood Creek 15; Amount of appropriation 1.03 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation June 13-1900; Description of land to be irrigated and for which this appropriation is determined and established.
