Whereas, Chas. Ball has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming, proof of the appropriation of water from Cottonwood Creek, Trib to Green River through the Island Ditch under permit No. 630 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the Provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has by an order duly made Nov. 28-1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No;3, page 100. determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
