D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3, page 100, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of Appropriator Chas. Ball; Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming, General Priority Number on main stream; 118; Priority Number on Cottonwood Creek Three (3) Amount of Appropriation 1.70 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation July 20, 1897; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined and established.

One Hundred and Eighteen acres---Being Thirty Eight (38) acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Twenty (20) acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
