Witnesseth, That the said party of the first for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, at or before the ensealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged has remised released and quit-claimed and by these presents does remise release and quit-claim, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain property situated in Uinta County, and State of Wyoming, and bounded and particularly described as follows: to wit: Permit No. 6367 An undivided one half interest in that certain irrigating ditch or canal known and recorded in State Engineers Office at Cheyenne Wyo, as the Walters Ditch taking Water for irrigation purposes from Green River.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof.
