

Certificate of Appropriation of Water.

Certificate Record 3 page 122.

Whereas, Wm. E. Mills Jr. has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming, proof of the appropriation of water from North Piney Trib to Green River through the Nelson Ditch under Permit No. 1819 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County Wyoming, and for irrigation.

Now Know Ye, that the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order duly made Nov. 28, 1902 and entered on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1903, in Order Record No. 3 page 93, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows: Name of appropriator Wm. E. Mills, Postoffice Address Big Piney Wyoming. General Priority Number on main stream; 126; Priority Number on North Piney 16 Amount of Appropriation, 3.40 cu.ft. per sec.; Date of appropriation May 9, 1898, Description of land to be irrigated and for which this appropriation is determined and established Two hundred & Thirty seven (237) acres being Thirty nine acres in lot four (40) Forty (40) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ S $\frac{1}{4}$ c. Five (5) Thirty nine (39) acres in Lot one (1) Thirty nine (39) acres in lot two (2) eighty (80) acres in S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ S $\frac{1}{4}$ six. (6) T. 30 N. R. 112 W.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Fred Bond, President of the State Board of Control, have hereunto set my hand this 28 day of May, A. D. 1903, and caused the seal of said Board to be hereunto affixed.
