

NOTICE AND CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION — LODGE

who is a Citizen..... of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization, hereby claim (s) the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim under and pursuant to the laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing his right thereto, hereby certify (certifies):

THAT ON the 17 day of MAY, 1966 which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of Chromite..... and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is G - 105

THAT THE LOCATOR..... of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 300 feet in a Westerly direction and 1500 feet in a Northwesterly direction and 1500 feet in a Southwesterly direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

THAT THE EXTERIOR boundaries of this location are distinctly marked by posts or monuments at each corner and its boundaries can be readily traced, viz:
