THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, *300* feet in a *W. 1/2 S. 1/2* direction and *1500* feet in a *N. 1/2 E. 1/2* direction and *1500* feet in a *S. 1/2 E. 1/2* direction, comprising in all *1500* feet in length and *600* feet in width.
