THAT ON the 28 day of June, 1966, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of Manganese and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is 9-11.

THAT THE LOCATOR..... of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 300 feet in a Westward direction and 1200 feet in a Northward direction and in width, 600 feet in a Eastward direction and 1200 feet in a Southward direction, comprising in all 1200 feet in length and 600 feet in width.
