who Citizen of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization, hereby claim (s) the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim under and pursuant to the laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing its right thereto, hereby certify (certifies):

THAT ON the 24 day of MAY, 1966, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is 4-56

THAT THE LOCATOR..... of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 700 feet in a North direction and 1000 feet in a direction and 600 feet in a direction and in width, 600 feet in a South direction and 1500 feet in length and 1000 feet in width.

THAT THE EXTERIOR boundaries of this location are distinctly marked by posts or monuments at each corner and its boundaries can be readily traced, viz:

BEGINNING AT NW corner of 1/4 sec 25-65-2 west of 36th South, the SW corner of sec 12, 13, 7, 18 bears 1500' East to NE corner, then South 07° 56' E for 1500' west to SW corner, then North 72° 00' West to point of beginning.

TIE: Corner No. NW of this claim bears 25-65-2 west of 36th South from Sec. Cor. 12, 13, 7, 18 (section corner or government monument.)

THAT DISCOVERY WORK as required by law has been performed on this claim as follows:


