who IS A Citizen..... of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization, hereby claim (s) the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim under and pursuant to the laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing H.I.S. right thereto, hereby certify (certifies):

•THAT ON the 2 day of September, 1966, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of URANIUM..... and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is N.W. 97

THAT THE LOCATOR..... of this claim (is) are the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 5 feet in a EASTERLY direction and 1495 feet in a WESTERLY direction and in width, 300 feet in a SOUTHELY direction and 300 feet in a NORTHERLY direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.
