THAT ON the 1st day of Sept, 1967, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of tin and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is Gap 18

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 1495 feet in a West direction and 5 feet in a East direction and in width, 200 feet in a North direction and 200 feet in a South direction, comprising in all 15.00 feet in length and 600 feet in width.
