## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT the undersigned PHILLIP E. FLANAGAN, RIVERTON, WYO., who is a citizen of the United States of America by birth, naturalization, or legal organization hereby claims the land described herein as a lode mining claim, pursuant to the laws of the United States and the State of Wyoming.

THAT on the 12 day of July, 1968, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals consisting of URANIUM and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT the name of this claim is GREEN 7.

THAT the extent of the claim is as follows:

Beginning at Corner No. 1 the NE Corner of this claim
