CASPER, WYOMINGKNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Terence L. Mack

having discovered this mineral lode, vein, or deposit within the claim hereby located, claim by right of discovery and location all Uranium, Thorium, and other fissionable materials plus Vanadium, Manganese and other non-fissionable associated minerals, under and in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress of May 10, 1872 and the laws of the State of Wyoming for mining purposes 1500 feet in length along or on this mineral lode, vein, or deposit with a width of 300 feet on each side of the middle of the lode, vein, or deposit at the surface; together with all the dips, spurs, angles and variations; also all water rights incident and appurtenant. 
