who is a Citizen of the United States of America, by birth, naturalization or legal organization, hereby claim(s) the land hereinafter described as a Lode Mining Claim, under and pursuant to the Laws of the United States of America and of the State of Wyoming, and, in making such claim and for the purpose of establishing _____ right thereto, hereby certify (certifies):

THAT ON the 19 day of August, 1968, which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is Sands #66THAT THE LOCATOR of this claim (is) (are) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 10 feet in a westerly direction and 1490 feet in a easterly direction and in width, 300 feet in a southerly direction and 300 feet in a northerly direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

THAT THE EXTERIOR boundaries of this location are distinctly marked by posts or monuments at each corner and its boundaries can be readily traced, viz:

BEGINNING AT Corner #1 which is the northeast corner, westerly 1500 feet to corner #2, thence southerly 600 feet to corner #3, thence easterly 1500 feet to corner #4, thence northerly 600 feet to Corner #1, the point of beginning. Corner #3 of this claim and Corner #4 of the Sands #65 are identical, and adjoin each other.
