THAT ON the 21 day of November, 19 69 which date is hereby established as the date of discovery, the undersigned discovered a lode, ledge, vein or deposit of valuable minerals, consisting of uranium and other valuable minerals, within the limits of this claim as hereinafter established.

THAT THE NAME of this claim is PROSPECT #21

THAT THE LOCATOR of this claim (is) (~~are~~) the undersigned, each owning an equal undivided share thereof, or the proportion after his name shown.

THAT THE EXTENT of this claim is as follows: From the point at which a copy of this Certificate is posted, the point of discovery, thence, in length, 150 feet in a easterly direction and 1350 feet in a westerly direction and in width, 300 feet in a northerly direction and 300 feet in a southerly direction, comprising in all 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width.

THAT THE EXTERIOR boundaries of this location are distinctly marked by posts or monuments at each corner and its boundaries can be readily traced, viz:
