Thence 1500 feet in an easterly direction to the northeast corner, the point of beginning.


The discovery monument lies midway between the two sides and is 10 feet from the EAST end and 1490 feet from the WEST end of this claim.

This claim is located in SE<sup>1</sup> Section 30 Township 31 North, Range 109 West, 6th p.m., Sublette County, Wyoming.


