Albert Larson, administrator of the Estate of David H. Riling, deceased, having on the 20 day of April, 1922, rendered and filed herein a full account and report of his administration of said Estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed a petition for the final distribution of the estate;

And said account and petition this day coming on regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that due notice of the settlement of said account, and the hearing of said petition in the manner and for the time required by law had been given;

And it appearing that said account is in all respects true and correct, and that said administrator has no funds in his hands and that all expenses of administration have been paid by the persons entitled to the residue of said estate, said statement and final account is now settled and allowed, and the acts of said administrator in connection with the administration of said estate are approved.

And it appearing that all claims and debts against said decedent, all taxes on said estate, and all debts, expenses and charges of administration, have been fully paid and discharged, and that said estate is ready for distribution and in condition to be closed;

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the said final account of the said administrator be and the same is settled, allowed and approved and that the residue of said estate hereinafter particularly described, and any other property not now known or discovered which may belong to the said estate, or in which the said estate may have any interest, be and the same is hereby distributed as follows, to-wit:

To William B. Riling, one undivided one-fifth part of the real estate;

To Emily C. Riling, one ^{undivided} one-fifth part of the real estate;

To Albert Ernest Riling, one undivided one-fifth part of the real estate;

To Nellie C. Morgan, one undivided one-fifth part of the real estate;

To Bertha E. Campbell, one undivided one-fifth part of the real estate.

The following is a particular description of the said residue of said estate referred to in this decree and of which distribution is now ordered, as aforesaid, to-wit:

Southeast quarter of the northwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), north half of the northeast quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-three (23), Township thirty-eight (38) North, Range 113 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian.

Together with all water and water rights thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
