QUADRUPLE AGREEMENT, made May 26, 1926, by and between PINEY PETROLEUM COMPANY, a Wyoming corporation, of Kemmerer, Wyoming; CLEO S. CLINTON, as and being the administrator of the ESTATE OF THOMAS CLINTON, DECEASED; and CLEO S. CLINTON, of Buhl, Idaho, hereinafter called "OWNERS", first parties, and CHARLES LACKEY, of Kemmerer, Wyoming, hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR", second party:

On or about November 3, 1923, pursuant to an application therefor, there was issued to said CLEO S. CLINTON, under section 13 of the Act of February 25, 1920, (41 Stat. 437) an oil and gas prospecting permit, Evanston, Wyoming, land office, serial No. 09485, describing therein the N E $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 31, township 29 N. R 113 W. 6th P M;

AND on or about February 19, 1923, there was issued to THOMAS CLINTON, now deceased, a like oil and gas prospecting permit, Evanston, Wyoming, land office, serial No. 07604, describing therein the E $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N W $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 33 - the W $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S E $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N E $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 28 - and the N $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 29; all in Town²⁹ N. of R. 113 W.; 6th P M; Wyoming; containing 1360 acres;

AND on or about August 12, 1922, there was issued to LINCOLN-IDAHO OIL COMPANY, a corporation, a like oil and gas prospecting permit, Evanston, Wyoming, land office serial No. 07762, describing therein all of section 30; lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the E $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N W $\frac{1}{4}$ section 31; Town²⁹ N. R 113 W. 6th P. M.; Wyoming; containing 893.63 acres; which last mentioned permit was thereafter by said LINCOLN-IDAHO OIL COMPANY assigned through mesne conveyance to said PINEY PETROLEUM COMPANY, reserving to said LINCOLN-IDAHO OIL COMPANY certain royalty upon the oil and gas production of the lands therein described;

The parties hereto believe the lands described in said several permits to contain valuable deposits of oil and gas; and

The "OWNERS" desire to contract for the exploitation, development and operation of said lands and the production of the oil and gas thereon, in compliance with the said Act of Congress and the regulations thereunder; and

"CONTRACTOR" is desirous to obtain the exclusive right to enter upon the lands described in said permits and to prospect thereon and to develop, produce, market and handle any and all oil and/or gas found therein; and

"OWNERS" have a quantity of tools, machinery, rigs and materials for drilling oil wells, and operations, as of their own property, which is also desired by "CONTRACTOR" for use on said lands, according to an approximate list of such tools, machinery, rigs and
