

Said owners represent and warrant that they are the owners of the above lands, and that they have not entered into any agreement with any other person or persons, firm or corporation affecting the lands above described, that no other person or persons, firm or corporation has acquired any rights to said lands; and the party of the first part agrees to protect the party of the second part against claims or rights asserted by other persons in or to said lands, heretofore described.

If the estate of either party hereto is assigned (and the right or privilege of assigning in whole, or in part, is expressly allowed) the covenants hereof shall extend to and become binding upon their heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, but no change in ownership of the land or assignment or royalties shall be binding on the lessee until after the lessee has been furnished with such written transfer or assignment or a true copy thereof; and it is hereby agreed that in the event this lease shall be assigned by the lessee as to a part or parts of the above described lands and the assignee or assignees or such part or parts shall make default in the payment of the proportionate part of the rents or royalties due from him or them, such default shall not operate to defeat or affect this lease in so far as it covers a part or parts of said lands upon which the said lessee or any assignee thereof shall have made due payment of said rental.
