THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 14th day of March, 1927, by and between the Utah Oil Refining Company, a Utah corporation, the party of the first part, and the Shidler Syndicate Number One, acting herein through D. R. Shidler, H. A. Reichenbach and K. S. Albert, trustees of said syndicate, the party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, on or about May 28, 1923, under the Act of February 25, 1920, (41 Stat. 437), there was issued to one W. D. Newlon a permit Serial No. Evanston 07814, granting to him the exclusive right to prospect for oil and gas the following described lands located in the so called LaBarge Field, Sublette County, Wyoming, to-wit:

All Section 18; W $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 20, and N $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 29, Township 27 North, Range 113 West, 6th P. M., Wyoming, containing 1270.64 acres, more or less; and,

WHEREAS, on or about February 7, 1925, an agreement was entered into between said W. D. Newlon and said Utah Oil Refining Company, whereby upon the terms and conditions therein set forth, said Utah Oil Refining Company acquired the right to operate and develop for oil and gas all of the lands embraced in said newlon permit, and whereby it also was given the right, upon the discovery of oil and/or gas in paying quantities, to designate one-quarter of the area embraced in said permit to be embraced in a lease bearing a minimum royalty to the United States of five per cent (5%), a copy of which said agreement is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A", and for reference purposes made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 24, 1926, under said Act, there was issued to one Marion W. Bird a permit Serial No. Evanston 010270, granting to her the exclusive right to prospect for oil and gas the following described lands in said LaBarge Field, to-wit:

All Section 21; N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 113 West, 6th P. M., Wyoming, containing 960 acres, more or less; and,

WHEREAS, prior to the issuance of said permit, to-wit: On or about February 17, 1925, an agreement was entered into by and between said Marion W. Bird and said Utah Oil Refining Company, whereby upon the terms and conditions therein set forth, said company, the party of the first part hereto, acquired the right to operate and develop for oil and gas the lands embraced in said Bird permit, and whereby it also was given the right, upon the discovery of oil and/or gas in paying quantities, to designate one quarter of the area embraced in said permit to be embraced in a lease bearing a minimum royalty to the United States of five per cent (5%), a copy of which agreement is hereto attached marked Exhibit "B", and for reference purposes made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the parties hereto that said lands contain valuable deposits of oil and gas, and the party of the first part is desirous of contracting for the exploitation, development and operation of the lands embraced in said Newlon permit and the operation of a portion of the lands embraced in said Bird permit, and for the production of the oil and gas contained therein, in compliance with the terms of said agreements and said permits, and any lease or leases which may be issued pursuant to said permits or either of them, and the Act of Congress and the Regulations promulgated thereunder, with a reservation to itself, however, of the right to purchase all oil and/or gas produced and saved therefrom; and,

WHEREAS, said Shidler Syndicate Number One, the party of the second part, is desirous of obtaining the right to enter upon said lands and to prospect thereon and de-
