THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the seventh day of August, 1928, by and between John G. Hartman of Denver, Colorado, hereinafter known as the Party of the First Part, and Miller Robert Taylor of Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter known as the Party of the Second Part,

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Party of the First Part is the owner of an oil lease or leases embracing certain lands in Lincoln County, State of Wyoming, more particularly described as follows:
