GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by These Presents, that we, Charles McConnell and Anna B. McConnell, man and wife, of Honesburg, County of Franklin, State of New York, have made, constituted and appoint David H. Johnston, of Daniel, Uinta County, Wyoming, our true and lawful attorney for us and in our names, place and stand, and for our use and benefit, to ask, demand, sue for, recover collect and receive all such sums of money, debts, dues, accounts, legacies, bequests, interests, dividends, annuities, and demands whatsoever as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable, or belongin_ to us, and have, use and take all lawful ways and means in our names or otherwise for the recovery thereof, by attachments, arrests, distress, or otherwise and to compromise and agree for the same, and acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same, for us and in our names to make seal and deliver; to bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive and take lands, tenements, hereditaments, and accept the same and possession of all lands, and all deeds and other assurances, in the law therefore, and to lease let, demise, bargain, sell, remise, release and convey, mortgage and hypothecate lands, tenements and hereditaments, upon such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as he shall think fit. Also, to bargain and agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any way and manner deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in possession or in action, and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of what nature or kind soever, and also for us and in our names, and at our act and deed, to sign seal, execute, deliver, and acknowledge such deeds, lenses and assignment of lenses, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, hypothecations, bottomries, charter-parties, bills of lading, bills, bonds, notes, receipts, evidences of debts, releases and satisfaction of mortgage, judgment and other debts, and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises. Giving and granting unto our said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as we might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that our said attorney, or his substitute or substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents until revoked.
