ORDER SETTING APART EXEMPT PROPERTY.

This matter coming on to be heard this 14th day of June, 1926, upon the petition of Frank Shipley, administrator of said estate, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the order to show cause why the exempt property of said estate should not be set over and assigned to the person or persons entitled thereto has been published for the time and in the manner as directed by the Court and in accordance with the statutes of the state of Wyoming;

And it further appearing to the Court that said Effie E. Shipley, deceased, was at the time of her death, a resident of the County of Sublette, state of Wyoming, and left surviving a widower, Frank Shipley; that notice to creditors in the matter of said estate was duly published in the Big Piney Examiner, a newspaper published in the town of Big Piney, in said County of Sublette, state of Wyoming, for the time and in the manner required by law; that an inventory and appraisement herein having been duly made and filed, and the hereinafter described real estate having been appraised therein at not exceeding twenty five hundred dollars in value, to-wit: at the sum of One Thousand Dollars, and it appearing that said real estate is the whole of the estate of said deceased, and that no objections or exceptions have been filed herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court after hearing the evidence, and all and singular the law and the premises being by the Court here seen, heard, understood, and fully considered, it is by the Court ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, and this does ORDER, ADJUDGE AND DECREE, that the hereinafter described real estate, being the entire estate of said deceased, be, and the same is hereby set over, released, assigned to, and that the title thereof shall vest absolutely in Frank Shipley, the surviving widower and spouse of said decedent, as his sole property.

The lands, the title of which is here and now vested in the said Frank Shipley, widower as aforesaid, are described as follows:

Lots numbered eight (8) in Block numbered four (4) in C. P. MacGlashan's First Addition to the town of Big Piney, Sublette County, Wyoming, as surveyed, platted and recorded. Together with the one-story log and frame shingle roof dwelling house situate thereon.

It is further ordered, that no further proceedings shall be required in the administration of said estate, unless further estate be discovered.
