Barthlow did have or ought to have had, in and to the following described premises, to wit:

The North one-half of the southeast quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section eighteen (18) in Township Thirty-seven North, of Range One hundred and Ten West, of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Sublette County, Wyoming, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, together with any and all privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto in anywise appertaining or belonging.

Hereby releasing any and all rights, benefits, privileges, advantages and exemptions under and by virtue of the State of Wyoming laws and the laws of the United States of America so far as they apply to said land or to exemptions thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said premises unto the said United States of America and it's assigns, to it's and their own proper use and behoof forever. So that neither the estate of the said Eliza D. Barthlow nor the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, or any other person in it's or their name or behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
