That he is a resident of the City of St. Louis, state of Missouri, having been domiciled therein for more than ten (10) years, and that he was well and personally acquainted with Cyrus F. Fish, during the life time of the said Cyrus F. Fish, who was and had been a resident of the County of St. Louis, state of Missouri, and did know him well and personally for twenty (20) years prior to the 14th day of July, 1924, and thereafter until his death.

That affiant is a nephew of the said Cyrus F. Fish; that said Cyrus F. Fish resided with affiant and his family in the City of St. Louis, state of Missouri for several years prior to the 14th day of July, 1924, and to the date of his death.

That said Cyrus F. Fish is the same and identical person who as grantor by a certain warranty deed, dated July 14th, 1924, and acknowledged on the same date, conveyed and sold to William E. Fish, as grantee, the following described real property situate in Sublette County, state of Wyoming, to-wit:

The south-half of southeast quarter (S½SE¼), northeast quarter of southwest quarter (NE¼SW¼), and the south-half of the southwest quarter (S½SW¼) of Section twenty-two (22) north-half of northeast quarter (N½NE¼) of Section twenty-seven (27) in Township Thirty (30) North, Range One Hundred Twelve (112) West, and the southwest quarter (SW¼) of Section Thirty-five (35) in Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range One Hundred Twelve (112) West, and Lot one (1) of Section Three (3) in Township Thirty (30) North, Range One Hundred Twelve (112) West, and southeast quarter of the north-east quarter (SE¼NE¼), east-half of the southeast quarter (E½SE¼) of Section Thirty Four (34), Township Thirty-One (31) North, Range One Hundred Twelve (112), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian. Also, Lots Three (3), four (4), and Five (5), in Block Eight (8), and Lot Eighteen (18) in Block Thirteen (13), and Lots Six (6), and Seven (7) in Block Fifteen (15), and Lot Seventeen (17) in Block Eleven (11) in the town of Big Piney, Wyoming, as said lots are laid down and described on the plat of the C.
