This certifies that the tracts of land described in the foregoing list have been carefully examined and compared with the township plats and tract books in this office, and the same have been found to inure to the State of Wyoming under its grant for the purpose stated, being free from conflicts or other adverse claims of record. The Geological Survey has reported subsequent to the completion of these selections that there are no valuable deposits of coal or other minerals within the areas specified and that since the selections in Evanston 010945 were completed prior to the Executive order of April 17, 1926, clear-listing of the lands in that case, as to watering places for public value does not appear necessary. There are no withdrawals or reservations of record in this office.
