TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

KNOW YE, THAT Thomas L. Clementsen, a Private of Company C, Third Regiment Nebraska Infantry, Volunteers, who was enrolled on the twentieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, at Omaha, Nebraska, to serve two years, was HONORABLY DISCHARGED from the service of the United States on the eleventh day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, by reason of muster out of the company.

THIS CERTIFICATE is given under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, "To authorize the Secretary of War to furnish certificates in lieu of lost or destroyed discharges," to honorably discharged officers of enlisted men or their widows, upon evidence that the original discharge certificate has been lost or destroyed, and upon the condition imposed by said Act that this certificate "shall not be accepted as a voucher for the payment of any claim against the United States for pay, bounty, or other allowances, or as evidence in any other case."

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF FRANK DeGRAW
FOR VOLUNTARY DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT OF
CERTAIN RIGHTS UNDER THE SAN JUAN DITCH DIVERTING
WATER FROM BEAVER CREEK, TRIBUTARY SOUTH PINEY
CREEK, PRIORITY APRIL 3, 1901, ADJUDICATED IN THE

THIS MATTER coming regularly before the State Board of Control the 14th day of November, 1929, the Board FINDS:

That on July 16, 1929, Frank De Graw filed with the State Board of Control a petition requesting the voluntary abandonment of an appropriation of water from Beaver Creek, tributary of South Piney Creek, diverted through the San Juan Ditch, for the irrigation of:

20 a. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20; 32 a. NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 12 a. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T. 28 N., R. 113 W.

Petitioner sets forth under oath and by documentary evidence that he is the owner of a $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T. 28 N., R. 113 W.,

That the appropriation of water from Beaver Creek, tributary of South Piney Creek with priority of April 3, 1901, diverted through the San Juan Ditch, for the irrigation of the above described lands has been abandoned, and no beneficial use of water has been made on said lands for five years last past;

The Board being advised by the records of the office of the State Board of Control and the office of the State Engineer, and the evidence presented, THEREFORE ORDERS;

That the petition be GRANTED;

That the appropriation of water from Beaver Creek, tributary of South Piney Creek, with priority of April 3, 1901, diverted by means of the San Juan Ditch for the irrigation of 20 a. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20; 32 a. NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 12 a. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T. 28 N., R. 113 W., adjudicated in the name of K. Thornton, (Permit No. 3106) Order Record 3, Page 273, Certificate Record 6, Page 42) be, and the same is hereby CANCELLED, and made null and void.
