This certifies that the tracts of land described in the foregoing list have been carefully examined and compared with the township plats and tract books in this office, and the same have been found to inure to the State of Wyoming, under its grant for the purpose stated, being free from conflicts or other adverse claims of record. The Geological Survey and the Chief of Field Division have reported subsequent to the completion of these selections that there are no valuable deposits of coal or other minerals within the area specified. The Survey's report in the case of Cheyenne 041883 completed and allowed subsequent to Executive order of April 17, 1926 (51 L. D. 437), after clearlisting the tracts therein as to coal and other minerals, added that the area specified shows no basis for objection to clearlisting this case as to springs and water holes of the type intended to be included in public water reserve No. 107. There are no withdrawals or reservations of record in this office.
