This matter this day came on regularly to be heard upon the petition of Mamie K. Johnson, widow of said deceased, for an order setting over to her as her absolute property all the property of said decedent, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of this Court that due notice of this hearing had regularly been given as required by law and no cause being shown or objections made why all of the property of the estate of said deceased should not be set over to the said widow and the Court having heard all the evidence adduced doth find;

That all the property of said estate, more particularly hereinafter described, is of a value less than \$2500.00, and is exempt from execution under the exemption laws of this state, including the homestead, and that the same should be set over to said widow as her absolute property, and all singular the law, the evidence and the premises, being heard, seen and understood by the Court

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That all that Real property, situated in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, and described as follows, to-wit:

The South half of the North half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section twelve (12), in Township Thirty-three (33), Range One Hundred and eight (108) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, all located in Sublette County, Wyoming, containing 160 acres, and appraised at \$6.25 per acre as shown by the Inventory and Appraisal filed in the above entitled cause

be and the same is hereby set over to Mamie K. Johnson, the widow of said deceased, as her absolute property, her heirs and assigns forever, and that no further proceedings shall be required in the administration of said estate unless further estate is discovered.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certified copy of this decree be recorded in the office of the County Clerk and ex-officio Register of Deeds within and for said County.

Now on this 8th day of August, A. D. 1930, this matter coming on regularly to be heard by the Court on the Petition of Mason E. Phillips, for the Determination of the heirs of Clifford Y. Phillips, deceased, and witnesses having been sworn and having testified herein it is adjudged and decreed that said Clifford Y. Phillips died intestate on the 29th day of July, 1918, at Chateau Therrie, France, and was at the time of his death, a resident of Sublette County, Wyoming, as now organized; that prior to the death of said deceased, he had made entry on government lands and had not received a patent therefor. Said land being described as follows, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twelve (12), Township Thirty-five (35) North of Range 112 West, and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Lots three (3) and Four (4) in Section Seven (7) Township 35 North of Range 111 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sublette County, Wyoming.
