WHEREAS, Levi Simmons has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from Big Twin Tributary of Green River through the Simmons Ditch under Permit No. 2670 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Uinta County, Wyoming, and for irrigation.
