Now on this eleventh day of June, 1925 this matter coming on regular to be heard by the court of the petition of plaintiff filed herein and it appearing to the court that service of summons herein was had upon the above named defendant by publication of said summons in "The Pinedale Roundup", a newspaper of general circulation in said Sublette County in the manner and for the time required by the law; and that proof of said publication has been duly made and filed herein by the affidavit of the publisher of said newspaper and the said defendant being in default herein for want of answer or other plea, the said defendant is now three times called in open court and comes not, and herein makes default; and said default is now taken and entered herein; and witnesses on behalf of plaintiff having been sworn having testified herein, and the court being now so advised as to the law and fact, doth say and find:

That Plaintiff and Defendant, at all times herein mentioned were, and now are respectively, corporations organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming; That Plaintiff owns and is in actual possession of the following described real estate, situate in said Sublette County, to-wit:

the north half of the northeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Twenty-seven North, of Range One Hundred Twelve West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Plaintiff purchased said real estate, through and by mesne conveyance from Charles Bird and Lulu C. Bird, husband and wife, the original patentees from the United States of said real estate; that said Charles Bird and Lulu Bird, his wife, on or about the 28th day of February, 1901, mortgaged said real estate to the above named Defendant, said the Opal Supply Company, for and in the sum of \$492.00, which said mortgage was thereupon recorded in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds in and for the County of Uinta, in said State of Wyoming, on the 6th day of March, 1901, in Book "F" of Mortgages, page 63, and thereafter transcribed into the Transcribed Records of said Sublette County in Book 3 of Transcribed Mortgages, page 254; That the said Charles Bird and Lulu C. Bird, his wife, duly paid said mortgage when it became due, but in ignorance of their rights failed to obtain a cancellation thereof; that said defendant corporation, The Opal Supply Company, has ceased
