KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that W. F. Hibben, of the town of Daniel, County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, for and in consideration of the sum of one and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollar, to him in hand paid by D. A. Blackmon and W. D. Blackmon, doing business as D. A. Blackmon and Son, of the aforesaid County and State, the receipt, whereof is hereby confessed, does hereby Grant to the said D. A. Blackmon and Son, a certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on a point which is 527 feet South and 508 feet East of the North West corner of Section two, Township thirty three North, Range 111 West and running thence East 392 feet and terminating on the South West Corner of the Joseph Huston Lot, a point which is 527 feet South and 900 feet East of the Northwest corner of the said Section two.

To have and to hold and use continuously and perpetually, the said described tract of land, for the uses and procedures and for the purposes hereinafter set out.

It is expressly understood that the said right of way shall be used for the purpose of erecting and maintaining electric light poles and guy wires for the purpose of selling, delivering, and distributing electricity to the inhabitants of the Town of Daniel, Wyoming.
