That he is the Attorney for the Green River Lumber Company; that at all times and dates hereinafter mentioned the Green River Lumber Company was a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Wyoming.

That at all times and dates hereinafter mentioned Mrs. Ethel Elves was engaged in building an apartment and cabin camp building upon the following described lands and premises, to-wit:

Lots 1 and 2 in Block 2 of the Jones Addition to the Town of Pinedale, Sublette County, Wyoming, as said addition is shown on the plat of said addition and Town now on file in the office of the County Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, together with all improvements situate or located thereon.
