This agreement, made and entered into this 19th day of October, 1938, by and between D. C. Carson, of Pinedale, Wyoming, hereafter referred to as party of the first part and Frank L. Korfanta, of Rock Springs, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, hereafter referred to as Party of the Second Part WITNESSETH:

That party of the first part hereby agrees to sell and the party of the second part agrees to buy the following described goods and chattels:

All of the stock of drugs, medicines, biologicals, both human and veterinarian, feminine hygiene, and prophylactics, belonging to that certain business operated under the firm name and style of the Carson Drugs which shall be on hand on the 28th, 29th, and 30th of October, 1938.

The party of the second part agrees to pay the party of the first part the cost price of the inventory of the above described stock of goods. Said sum of to be paid immediately upon determining the amount after the inventory has been taken. It is further understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the party of the second part will pay to the party of the first part at the time of the payment above mentioned, the sum of \$300.00. Said sum to be paid for the good will and business held by the party of the first part, and the said sum of \$300.00 is hereby considered to be the consideration for said good will and drug business.

It is further understood by and between the parties hereto that as part of the consideration of this agreement, paid to the party of the first part by the party of the second part, the party of the first part will not, either directly or indirectly, engage or be interested in the selling of drugs, medicines, biologicals, either human or veterinarian, feminine hygiene, and prophylactics, for a period of three years from the first day of November, 1938.

It is further understood and agreed that the party of the first part shall not buy or sell any of said articles in this Agreement mentioned, nor engage in the manufacturing, either wholesale or retail, within the limits of Sublette County, Wyoming, and that he will not, either directly or indirectly, finance, aid, or encourage any one to carry on the business herein mentioned, either at wholesale or retail, in said Sublette County, Wyoming, for a period of three years from November, 1938.
