KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Ray W. Downer and Ira Downer citizens of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years and residing in the County of Cowlitz and State of Washington, having discovered a vein or lode of quartz, or rock in place, bearing valuable minerals within the claim hereby located, claim by right of discovery and location, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter 2, Title 30, and the laws of the State of Wyoming 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement along the vein or lode thereof, with all its dips, variations and angles, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the discovery shaft, or discovery workings; and all veins, lodes, ledges, deposits and surface grounds within the lines of said claims and within the operation and affect of said U.
