KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, T. D. O'NEIL CO., INC. of the County of Sublette and the State of Wyoming hereinafter called the grantor, hereby grants to the State of Wyoming, hereinafter called the grantee, the right to lay out, construct, inspect, operate and maintain a road for the use of the public over and across the following described land located in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, to-wit:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Sec. 28; W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Sec. 21, T. 32 N., R. 111 W., of the 6th P.M., Wyoming.

The location, width of right of way hereby granted is as follows:

A parcel of land 200 feet wide located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section 28, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section 21, all in T. 32 N., R. 111 W., of the 6th Principal Meridian, Sublette County, Wyoming. Said parcel of land is bounded by parallel lines measured 100 feet each side of and at right angles to the center-line of highway and by the prolongations of said parallel lines to the legal boundaries of above described lands and by those portions of the legal boundaries of said described lands which are intercepted between said parallel lines as prolonged. The course of said center-line of highway being described as follows: /NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Beginning at a point on the South boundary of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ in said Sec. 28, which point is S. 20° 55' W., 889.8 feet, of a point which is S. 25° 37' W., 521.8 feet, of a point on the North boundary of said Sec. 28, from whence the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. thereof bears N. 87° 12' W., 496.0 feet; THENCE N. 20° 55' E., 419.5 feet, to the point of a 0° 30' curve to the right, the radius of which is 11459.2 feet, THENCE along said curve thru an angle of 4° 42', 940.0 feet; THENCE N. 25° 37' E., 4425.5 feet, to a point on the North boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in said Sec. 21, which point is S. 25° 37' W., 523.7 feet, of a point on the East boundary of said Sec. 21, from whence the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner thereof bears S. 0° 25' E., 1871.5 feet.

The above described parcel of land containing 26.56 acres, more or less.

Grantor also grants the right of ingress and egress to and from the said land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by the grantee, and the public, of the rights granted by this conveyance.

Grantee agrees to fence the right of way on both sides with 4 wire fence with posts 20 feet apart, with gates at such points as are necessary. Grantor to maintain fence thereafter.

Grantee agrees to construct culverts of suitable size across such ditches and laterals of grantor as necessary for proper operation of his irrigation system.

Grantors hereto do hereby waive and release all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Wyoming insofar as affected by this conveyance.

The grant herein contained is an easement and shall be perpetual so long as said land is used for the aforementioned purposes.
