Edwards and Fred Ecklund, an easement of Right of Way, over, upon and across the following described land, situated in Sublette County, Wyoming:

To have and to use continuously and perpetually, only for the specific purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining an irrigation ditch thereon, the location and extension of which is described as follows:

A Right of Way for the Willow Creek Supplemental Ditch and lateral thereof 30 feet in width, being 15 feet on each side of a center line described by the following survey: Beginning at the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 19, T. 34 N.R. 109 W, the headgate is located N. 28 45' E. 550 feet. It is expressly understood that upon abandonment of the ditch described herein, the right of the said Grantees to the use of said land shall terminate, and all rights conveyed herein shall revert to the Grantor, his heirs, successors and assigns, the same as if this grant had never been made.
