FINAL DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION

The petition of G. B. Hockett, administrator with will annexed of the Estate of T. R.
Wineman, also known as Ted R. Wineman, and sometimes known as Teddy R. Wineman, deceased,
heretofore filed herein praying for the distribution of the Estate of T. R. Wineman, also
known as Ted R. Wineman, and sometimes known as Teddy R. Wineman, deceased, among the per-
sons entitled thereto, coming on regularly this day for hearing and it appearing that due
notice of said hearing has been given as required by law; that there have been no claims
filed against said estate; that the final account of said administrator has been duly made
and has been confirmed by this Court; that all taxes due from said estate, including inherit-
ance tax, have been paid.

That said deceased died testate on the 17th day of July, 1938; and that his only heirs-
at-law as far as known to your petitioner are:

Jean Wineman, widow of said deceased, aged more than 21 years, residing
at Derry, Pennsylvania;
Theodore H. Wineman, son of deceased, aged more than 21 years, residing
at Derry, Pennsylvania;
Helen L. Wineman, daughter of deceased, a minor, residing at Derry,

and that the said widow, Jean Wineman, is the sole legatee and devisee under the terms and
as provided for in said decedent's Last Will and Testament admitted to probate in this Court
on the 26th day of January, 1940. That on the said 26th day of January, 1940, Arthur E.
Oeland was appointed administrator with will annexed of said Estate; and that on the 14th
day of August, 1940 he duly qualified and entered upon the duties of his said trust.

That thereafter, to-wit: on the 1st day of May, 1941, said Arthur E. Oeland filed his
resignation from said office with this Court, and his said resignation was duly accepted and
approved by this Court on the 7th day of May, 1941; that thereafter on the said 7th day of
May, 1941, Bertha A. Butwell was appointed administratrix with will annexed of said estate,
and on the 15th day of May, 1941, she duly qualified and entered upon the duties of her said
office; and thereafter on the 8th day of July, 1941, she filed her resignation in this Court
