KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, desiring to form a body politic and corporate; ie. A corporation for the purposes hereinafter set forth, under, by virtue of and in conformity with the laws of the State of Wyoming do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together and made this written certificate in duplicate and we do hereby certify:

I. The name of this corporation shall be, DUNCAN-FRANCE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.
