This agreement made this 31 day of July, 1941 between County of Sublette, of _____, State of Wyoming, grantor, and the United States of America, grantees:

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the construction by the grantees of the following improvements: Cattle guards, bridges, wood culverts to be furnished in lumber, the grantor assuming all labor and maintenance. The grantees will furnish some lumber and reserves the right to work on the following roads: and trails: Boulder, Newfork, Piney-South Piney, and Kendall roads and the grantor does hereby grant, bargain, convey, and confirm unto the United States of America, an easement and right of way over the tract, lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Boulder, Newfork, Piney-South Piney, and Kendall roads and Merna Stock Driveway all lying within Sublette District and Sublette County, Wyoming. All roads and stock driveways as mentioned are used as stock driveways by livestock, Ranchers and by the Grazing Service for administrative purposes.

The said easement and right of way hereby granted is for the full, free, unrestricted, and quiet use and enjoyment by the grantees of the land of the grantor, occupied by the said improvements, for any and all purposes deemed necessary or beneficial for, or in connection with, the control, administration, or use of the public land surrounding or adjacent to the land herein described, which may be properly grazed from, serviced by, or used in connection with the said land and improvements, including the right of ingress and egress to, from, and over the land of the said grantor by the grantees, its officers, agents, permittees, allottees, and licensees for the purpose of repairing, renewing, or using the said improvements, or for other business pertaining to the use and maintenance thereof, and shall be appurtenant to said public land.

This grant shall be effective as long as the said land shall be actually used for the aforesaid purposes, and all rights hereunder shall revert to the grantor when and in the event the said use thereof shall be discontinued or abandoned, of which due notice shall be given to the grantor by the grantees.
