KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Thomas Thompson, single, of the County of Sweetwater in the State of Wyoming for and in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$6000) and other good and valuable considerations, to him in hand well and truly paid at or before the signing, sealing and delivery of these presents by William D. Thompson of the County of Sweetwater in the State of Wyoming the receipt whereof he, the said Thomas Thompson does hereby acknowledge, has granted, bargained, sold and delivered by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said William D. Thompson the following goods and chattels, to-wit:

All and singular his entire right, title and interest in the sheep and other livestock, choses in action, property and equipment of every kind, class and description owned by that certain partnership known as Thompson and Son, originally composed of Joseph Thompson, Sr., Thomas Thompson and Joseph Thompson, Jr., and now composed of Thomas Thompson, John L. Thompson and William B. Thompson; it being intended hereby to sell to the grantee, William D. Thompson, the entire interest of the said Thomas Thompson in and to the partnership and the property thereof.

To have and to hold the said granted and bargained goods and chattels unto the said William D. Thompson and to his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to their only proper use, benefit and behoof forever; and he the said Thomas Thompson does vouch himself to be the true and lawful owner of the goods and chattels hereby sold, and to have in himself full power, good right and lawful authority to dispose of the said goods and chattels in the manner as aforesaid, and he does for himself and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend the said good and chattels unto the said William D. Thompson, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
