

This cause came on regularly for trial this 7 day of June, 1943, the plaintiff appearing by his attorney, Paul Ziegler, and the defendants appearing not, but making default, the Court proceeded to examine the records and files in this cause and to hear the testimony from which it appears and the Court finds:

That said defendants were duly and regularly served with Summons and process in this action in the manner required by the laws of the State of Wyoming, and except as shall herein after appear, each and all of them have failed to plead, answer, or otherwise appear, in this action within the time prescribed by law, or at all, and the default of the defendants, for failing to plead, answer or otherwise appear in this action, has been duly and regularly entered herein.

That the plaintiff herein caused an affidavit to be filed showing that he is unable to determine whether the defendants are in the military service of the United States of America, and the application being made for the appointment of an attorney under the provisions of the Act of Congress known as "The Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940," E. V. Magagna, an attorney at law duly licensed to practice before this Court was appointed by the Order of this Court to represent said defendants, and to protect their interests under the said Act of Congress, and the said E. V. Magagna appeared herein for said defendants and filed an answer to said petition.

That all the material allegations of plaintiff's petition are true and sustained by testimony free from all legal exceptions.

That the plaintiff is the absolute owner of and is in possession of the following described real property situate in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West two-thirds of the West half of the Southeast quarter (W 2/3 of the W $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3); the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Four (4); the North half of the Northeast quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9); North half of the Northwest quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West two-thirds of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (W 2/3 of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10), all in Township thirty-two North (32N), Range one hundred eight West (108W), Sixth (6th) P. M., Wyoming.

And the Court further finds that the claims of the defendants and each of them, if such claims there be, are null and void, and that the defendants, and each of them, are without any right whatsoever in and to said real property and premises.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED that judgment may be entered for the plaintiff and against the defendants, and that no bond be required from the plaintiff to the said defendants under the provisions of "The Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940," and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the plaintiff, is the absolute owner of and in possession of the real property and premises in this decree above described, and that the estates or interests therein, if any there be, adverse to the plaintiff, are hereby declared to be null and void, and that the plaintiff's title to all of said real property and premises above described is hereby quieted against each and every claim of the defendants, and each of them.
